DEEPER project designed an integrate and EU based innovative program for refugees and trainers . The project aimed to outline an innovative methodology of distance training of refugees trainers in the linguistic and professional field through the use of the web. We have outlined and we are applying a methodology training at a distance, through the system of the Complex Learning, adapting to the conditions of the trainers of refugees and migrants. 3 pilot training sessions in Italy involved more than 100 trainers during which we presented the on line platforms Deeper, available at <http://www.didalearning.com/deeper/elgg/web/> and now operating as learning tool.

The aim was to have effective tools for continuous training of trainers of refugees, without using the traditional techniques of the course with content defined. Trainers have something to share both with regard to training methods and also to the techniques used as well as to difficulties encountered and good practises tested.

In the final Conference in Brussels we will present the results of this promising practice and we would open new horizons of operation. The Conference will be an opportunity to relaunch the debate on “training of trainers” as crucial field to have a successful integration of persons in need of international protection”, Alongside national and NGO stakeholders, representatives from the European Parliament, the European Commission and UNHCR will explore and discuss forms of integration of refugee protection.
