diversity of cultural, cognitive and motivational learning schema, also valorising informal learning schema.

Giving each appointment the next Consortium Meeting to be held in Spain in September, the partners leave Rome. This meeting will be assessed and compared the progress made around the design and development of deliverables.

### A strategy for dissemination
